



RESOLUTION 26-11

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LILAC LANE SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Lake Area Sanitary District (ALASD) was created by Act of the Minnesota State Legislature, Chapter No. 869-1971, as amended, and ALASD is responsible for providing sanitary sewer infrastructure and service within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, improvements are necessary to accommodate infrastructure needs associated with Lake Victoria Resort; and

WHEREAS, said improvements include the extension of approximately eighty (80) feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main, installation of a new manhole, and associated system upgrades; and

WHEREAS, additional improvements include road restoration after excavation work and the elimination of sanitary sewer services that are no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, ALASD solicited quotes for the project and the lowest responsible quote was submitted by Mark Lee Excavation in the amount of \$53,500; which includes all mobilization, materials, labor, permitting, traffic control, turf establishment, and bituminous street restoration; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Alexandria Lakes Area Sanitary District as follows:

1. The Lilac Lane Sanitary Sewer Extension and Improvements project is hereby approved, including extension of approximately 80 feet of 8-inch sewer main, installation of a new manhole, road restoration, and removal of unused services.
2. The contract for said project is hereby awarded to Mark Lee Excavation in the amount of \$53,500 as the lowest responsible quote.
