

RESOLUTION 26-16

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CSAH 23 SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION FOR THE BENEFIT OF HUDSON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Lake Area Sanitary District (ALASD) was created by an act of the Minnesota State Legislature, Chapter No. 869 - 1971, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Township requested the extension of public sanitary sewer service along County State Aid Highway 23 (CSAH 23) to serve benefited parcels identified as PID 21-0041-000, PID 21-0042-895, and PID 21-0040-000, all within the Township; and

WHEREAS, ALASD is willing to undertake and administer the sanitary sewer extension on behalf of and for the benefit of Hudson Township, including the force-main extension, three residential grinder-pump stations, and the associated electrical hookups necessary to place the grinder stations into service; and

WHEREAS, Tradesmen Construction, Inc., through its July 9, 2026 written quote, proposed to complete the quoted construction and installation scope for **\$60,204**, including the force-main piping, installation of three E-One grinder-pump stations, connection work, septic-tank abandonment, and restoration, with electrical work expressly excluded; and

WHEREAS, Hudson Township has agreed to pay ALASD \$75,000 upon completion of the project and intends to recover that amount through special assessments against the three benefited parcels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sanitary Sewer Board of the Alexandria Lake Area Sanitary District, that the CSAH 23 Sanitary Sewer Extension is hereby approved for the benefit of Hudson Township and the three parcels identified above; that the July 9, 2026 Tradesmen Construction, Inc. quote in the amount of \$60,204 is acknowledged as the basis for the quoted construction scope; and that the Executive Director is authorized to execute the necessary agreements and project documents and take all actions reasonably necessary to complete the extension. ALASD shall furnish the three residential E-One grinder-pump stations and provide the associated electrical hookups, which were excluded from the Tradesmen quote. Upon completion, ALASD shall invoice Hudson Township for the fixed amount of **\$75,000**.
